- All of the following medications can be administered
- Acetaminophen (headaches, general aches and pains)
- Acetaminophen, dexamethorphan HBr, Doxylamine Succinate (Nyquil cold)
- Activated Charcoal (Upset stomach, diarrhea, gas)
- Alcohol Swab (Antiseptic skin prep)
- Aloe Vera (sunburn and minor burn relief)
- Antiseptic Wash (for minor cuts, scrapes and burns)
- BioFreeze (temporary relief of minor aches and pains of sore muscles and joints)
- Calcium Carbonate (antacid tablets)
- Cetrizine HCl (24 hour allergy relief, seasonal allergies)
- Chap Stick
- Cough drops
- Diphenhydramine HCL (allergies, hives, night time sleep aid)
- Glucose (Low blood sugar)
- Guaifenesin

- Hydrocortisone cream
- Ibuprofen (headaches, general aches and pains)
- Imodium and generic (diarrhea)
- Lip Clear plus Lysine (cold sores)
- Loratadine (24 hour allergy relief, seasonal allergies)
- Melatonin (Sleep aid)
- Midol and generic **for Female students** (contains Acetaminophen, caffeine, pyrilamine maleate for menstrual relief)
- Phenylephrine HCl (sinus decongestant)
- Purified water (eye wash)
- Povidone-Iodine swab (Antiseptic/Germicide used to clean minor wounds)
- Saline Spray (wound wash)
- Saline Nasal spray (Relief of dry nasal membranes)
- Sodium Carboxy-methylcellulose (eye lubricant)
- Sun Screen
- Triple antibiotic Ointment
- Throat Spray (Sore Throat)
- Vitamin C
